

Example Table with Merged Cells

Header Row - This cell spans across all four columns and provides a title or summary for the entire table content below.			
Merged Vertically - This cell spans two rows and typically contains category labels or descriptive data.	This is cell (1,1) with additional details explaining its purpose.	This is cell (1,2), often used for notes or extended content.	This is cell (1,3) which can hold further explanations or data.
	This is cell (2,1), part of the same row as the vertically merged cell.	This is cell (2,2) with more in-depth information.	This is cell (2,3), sometimes used to reference other data.
Cell (3,0) begins a new row and could indicate a different section.	Cell (3,1) continues with additional section-specific content.	Cell (3,2) may contain summaries or statistical info.	Cell (3,3) typically concludes a row with results or notes.
