## 2 FILE

- Bring a copy to your local courthouse to file at the Magistrate Clerk:
- There is a fee associated with filing. If you cannot afford the fee, you can file a Financial Affidavit to see if you are eligible to have your filing fee waived.

## OTHER INFORMATION

- Open your mail:  
The court will provide you notice of the landlord's reply and your court date by mail. It is important that you do not miss any notices.
- Bring your paperwork:  
Even though the judge will have the paperwork you filed, you should bring a copy of your paperwork as well.
- Phones not allowed:  
This means no digital evidence, such as videos or voicemails, will be accepted. Print any photos or materials you have to present to the Court. If you have a video that you need to show, you can try to contact the court ahead of time to see if they will accept it.
- Remember your manners:  
It is important to present yourself well. Dress nicely. Say "Yes, Your Honor" and "No, Your Honor." Do not speak while others are speaking, especially the judge.
- Arrive early:  
Depending on what is going on at the courthouse, there could be a delay in getting through security or your case could be called early. Arrive at least 10-15 minutes before your hearing is scheduled.
