

KSeF 2.0 API documentation and FA(3) logical structure published

The Ministry of Finance has released tools for integrating IT systems with KSeF 2.0. The KSeF 2.0 API documentation will allow integrators and companies to begin preparing for system implementation in a test environment.

KSeF 2.0 API Documentation

The API (Application Programming Interface) is a set of detailed rules and technical specifications that define how the National e-Invoice System (KSeF) exchanges data and interacts with external financial and accounting systems. Interoperability with KSeF 2.0 is possible for various invoicing software, regardless of manufacturer. Before a user can issue, send, or receive invoices, the software must first be integrated with KSeF 2.0 via the API.

Published API documentation includes:

- API technical documentation described in the Open API standard, in the form of an interactive technical portal that includes:
 - descriptions of methods,
 - data structures,
 - parameters and examples,
 - specification (OpenAPI JSON file), intended for use in integration automation tools (e.g. code generators, API contract validators).

Additionally, in order to facilitate the work of programming teams, the Ministry of Finance also published:

- SDK libraries that are a collection of tools and examples in two programming languages - Java and .Net,
- a manual containing instructions and code snippets that illustrate how to use key system endpoints,
- overview of key changes between KSeF API 2.0 and KSeF API 1.0 (the optional system currently in operation).

Logical structure of FA(3)

The Ministry of Finance has published the final version of the e-Invoice logical structure – FA(3). It was developed following extensive consultations with tax experts, accountants, auditors, invoicing software providers, and future users of the KSeF 2.0 API – including businesses, local government units, and non-governmental organizations.

We urge invoicing software providers to begin reviewing the KSeF 2.0 documentation in July and not postpone integration until the last minute. The system will become mandatory on February 1, 2026, said Marcin Łoboda, Deputy Minister of Finance and head of the National Revenue Administration.

KSeF implementation schedule

On September 30, 2025, the KSeF 2.0 API test environment will be made available, enabling software vendors and businesses to conduct tests. A test browser version of the KSeF Taxpayer Application is planned for November 2025, allowing users to test key functionalities of the KSeF system.

KSeF 2.0 will be made available as a mandatory version for all users from February 1, 2026. On the same day, the FA(3) logical structure will replace the current FA(2) logical structure.
